

Eurocode 6: Design of masonry structures

BS EN 1996 relates to buildings and other civil engineering works, and covers reinforced, prestressed and confined masonry.

The four parts of BS EN 1996 cover the rules for reinforced and unreinforced masonry, structural fire design and detailed rules for lateral loading.

The specific parts, and the relevant withdrawn British Standards, are:

BS EN 1996-1-1- General rules for reinforced and unreinforced masonry structures. Replaces BS 5628-1 and BS 5628-2

BS EN 1996-1-2- General rules. Structural fire design. Replaces BS 5628-3 BS EN 1996-2:2006- Design considerations, selection of materials and execution of masonry

BS EN 1996-3- Simplified calculation methods and simple rules for masonry structures
