Invitation to comment on MSPO Initial Assessment of Genting Plantations Berhad – Genting Ayer Item Palm Oil Mill and supply base, Air Hitam, Johor, Malaysia

Genting Plantations Berhad has appointed BSI to conduct MSPO Initial Assessment of its Genting Ayer Item Palm Oil Mill and supply base. The assessment will be conducted at 1 Palm Oil Mill and 5 Oil Palm Plantations which are managed by the company. The certification unit is located at Air Hitam, Johor, Malaysia

BSI plans to conduct initial assessment of Genting Ayer Item Palm Oil Mill from 22 & 23 January 2018.
