## Invitation to comment on MSPO Initial Assessment of Sime Darby Plantation Berhad – Flemington Palm Oil Mill and supply base, Teluk Intan, Perak, Malaysia

Sime Darby Plantation Berhad has appointed BSI to conduct MSPO Initial Assessment of its Flemington Palm Oil Mill and supply base. The assessment will be conducted at 1 Palm Oil Mill and 4 Oil Palm Plantations which are managed by the company. The certification unit is located at Teluk Intan, Perak, Malaysia
