Invitation to comment on MSPO Initial Assessment of TDM Plantation Sdn Bhd – Kemaman Palm Oil Mill & supply base – Kemaman, Terengganu, Malaysia

TDM Plantation Sdn Bhd has appointed BSI to conduct MSPO Initial Assessment of its Kemaman Palm Oil Mill and supply base. The assessment will be conducted at 1 Palm Oil Mill and 6 Oil Palm Plantations which are managed by the company. The certification unit is located at Kemaman, Terengganu, Malaysia.

BSI plans to conduct initial assessment of Kemaman Palm Oil Mill from 15 – 17 August 2017. The assessment will be conducted based on the MSPO MS 2530-3:2013 – *General principles for oil palm plantations and organized smallholders* & MS 2530-4:2013 – *General principles for palm oil mills*.
