**Invitation to comment on MSPO Initial Assessment of TSH Plantation Sdn Bhd – Lahad Datu Palm Oil Mill and supply base, Kinabatangan, Sabah, Malaysia**

TSH Plantation Sdn Bhd has appointed BSI to conduct MSPO Initial Assessment of its Lahad Datu Palm Oil Mill and supply base. The assessment will be conducted at 1 Palm Oil Mill and 2 Oil Palm Plantations which are managed by the company. The certification unit is located at Kinabatangan, Sabah, Malaysia
