


Building sustainable resilience in the palm oil industry



### MSPO certification benefits

Our Malaysian sustainable palm oil (MSPO) certification increases resilience across many parts of your business.

### Social

- Change in mindset and attitude of staff and workers; better team work.
- Better OHS risk management and reduction in workplace accidents.
- Improved communication and relationship with workers.
- More stable or loyal workforce; lower turnover rate.
- Improved communication and engagement with smallholder, local communities and others stakeholders.
- Enhanced productivity and well-being of associated smallholders.
- Improved community relations through increased consultation and engagement.

- Better access to international markets.
- Price premium for Crude Sustainable Palm Oil (CSPO).

## The Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO)

Endorsed by the Malaysian government in 2013, the Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO) certification scheme helps increase the resilience of Malaysia's oil palm management and supply chain and applies to plantations, independent and organized smallholdings, palm oil processing facilities as well as dealers and oil palm biomass. These programmes align the management of palm oil production with many existing national laws and regulations.

This series of the Malaysian Standard on Malaysian Sustainable Palm Oil (MSPO) is the Government of Malaysia's commitment to ensure the country's palm oil is sustainable. This is achieved through a balance between environmental, societal and economic considerations to meet the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their needs, in line with the UN SDGs agenda.

### MSPO 2530:2022 certification

MSPO certification scheme allows for growers (independent or organized smallholders or estates), millers, dealers, processing facilities and oil palm biomass to be certified as:

- · an individual estate
- · a group of estates
- · an individual smallholder
- · a group of smallholders
- an individual mill
- a combination of an estate, mill and/or smallholders
- · an individual of processing facilities
- · a multisite of processing facilities
- · an individual dealer
- an individual oil palm biomass

MSPO certification enables organizations to declare their products as sustainable.

### **Benefits of certification include:**

- Enhanced organizational reputations for being socially and environmentally responsible.
- Facilitated access to the growing green market.
- Supports significant growth and economic development opportunities for oil palm smallholders.
- Ensures sustainable and equitable use of resources without negatively impacting the environment or risking the health or safety of employees.
- Compliance with Government of Malaysia directive on MSPO certification.



# The MSPO standard is split into eight (8) parts.

The first part applies to all organizations, but the following parts are specific to the size and type of your organizations:

- 1. Part 1 General principles
- 2. Part 2 1 Independent Smallholders less than 40.46Ha
- 3. Part 2 2 Organized Smallholders less than 40.46Ha
- 4. Part 3 1 Oil Palm Plantations 40.46Ha to 500Ha
- 5. Part 3 2 Oil Palm Plantations more than 500Ha
- 6. Part 4 1 Palm Oil Mill inc. SC
- 7. Part 4 2 Palm Oil Processing Facilities inc. SC
- 8. Part 4 3 Dealers inc. SC

And MS 2751: 2022 MSPO Chain of Custody (CoC) of Oil Palm Biomass

Each standard is based on the following principles:

- 1. Management commitment and responsibility
- 2. Transparency
- 3. Compliance to legal & other requirements
- 4. Responsibility to social, health, safety, and employment condition
- Environment, natural resources, biodiversity, and ecosystem services
