## Section 2: Assessment Process

BSI is a leading global provider of management systems assessment and certification, with more than 80,000 certified locations and clients in over 190 countries. BSI Standards is the UK's National Standards Body. BSI provides independent, third-party certification of management systems.

### Assessment Methodology, Programme, Site Visits

This full remote assessment was conducted due to Pandemic COVID-19 from 29/03/2020 to 02/04/2020. The audit programme is included in Section 2.3. The approach to the audit was to treat the 770 smallholders as an MSPO Certification Unit. A range of environmental and social factors were covered. This includes consideration of topography, palm age, proximity to areas with HBVs, declared conservation areas and local communities.

The methodology for collection of objective evidence included physical site inspections, observation of tasks and processes, interviews of staff, workers and their families and external stakeholders, review of documentation and monitoring data. MS 2530-2:2013 was used to guide the collection of information to assess compliance. The comments made by external stakeholders were also taken into account in the assessment.

The estates or smallholders' sample were determined based on formula  $S = r\sqrt{n}$  where  $n$  is the number of estates while when applicable, the smallholders sample were determined following the MSPO Certification Requirement. The sampling of smallholders was based on the formula  $(r\sqrt{n})$ ; where  $r$  is the risk factor (may defer 1, 1.5 and 2 depending on risk), where  $n$  is total number of group members. The sampled smallholder listed in Appendix C. From the total of 770 smallholders, 324 are the existing members and 446 are new members. Samples were derived from the formula  $S = r\sqrt{n}$  separately with risk factor 1.5. Therefore, 10 samples from the existing members and 32 from the new members, which makes the total 42.

Meetings were held with stakeholders to seek their views on the performance of the company with respect to the MSPO requirements and aspects where they considered that improvements could be made. At the start of each meeting, the interviewer explained the purpose of the audit followed by an evaluation of the relationship between the stakeholder and the company before discussions proceeded. The interviewer recorded comments made by stakeholders and these have been incorporated into the assessment findings.

Structured interviews with smallholders were held remotely via phone call. A list of Smallholders and Stakeholders contacted is included as Appendix B.

All the previous nonconformities are remains closed. The assessment findings for the initial assessment are detailed in Section 4.2.

This report is structured to provide a summary of assessment finding as attached in the Section 3. The assessment was based on random samples and therefore nonconformities may exist that have not been identified.

This report was externally reviewed by MSPO approved Peer Reviewer prior to certification decision by BSI.

#### 3.1 Details of audit results

#### 3.2 Details of Nonconformities and Opportunity for improvement

The nonconformity is listed below.

During the Certification Assessment there were no nonconformities raised. The MPOB Sustainable Palm Oil Cluster (SPOC) S8 Beaufort Certification unit submitted Corrective Action Plans for the nonconformity. Corrective action plans with respect to the nonconformity was reviewed by the BSI audit team and accepted.

The implementation of the corrective action plans to address the minor nonconformity will be followed up during the next surveillance assessment. The implementation of the Corrective Actions for the Major Non-conformity(ies) has been verified for its effectiveness and closed accordingly.


